**Day Six:** Transfer to Edinburgh for golf at North Berwick West Links, a prime example of Scottish links golf. Accommodations: Tigerlily Hotel, boutique accommodations in the heart of Georgian Edinburgh.

**Day Seven:** Optional golf at Muirfield, considered by many to be the finest course in all of Europe. Gents walking tour of Edinburgh including stops at the finest pubs in the city. Accommodations: Tigerlily Hotel.
